


If you have your instrument and want to play, let's get you playing!

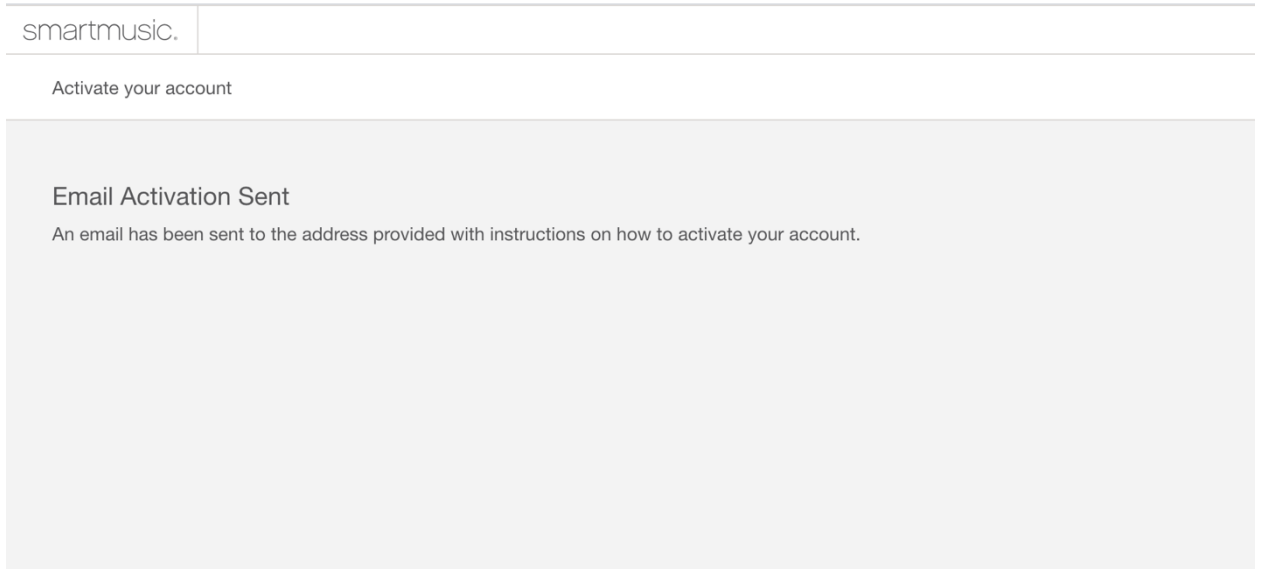
There is a GREAT program called SmartMusic! This gives you access to hundreds of books and pieces of music for free. Here are the directions to get started with Smart Music!

1. You must use CHROME as your internet browser. There is now app, and it won't work with other browsers.
2. Go to <https://admin.smartmusic.com/join>
3. Enter the appropriate code for your class:
 - 8-1: AWZDQ-C44GE
 - 8-2: HL3PR-RWUNR
 - 7-1: HWDNG-L74VF
 - 7-2: UEDK2-TV3VU
 - ALL Beginners: P2D23-KMN4V

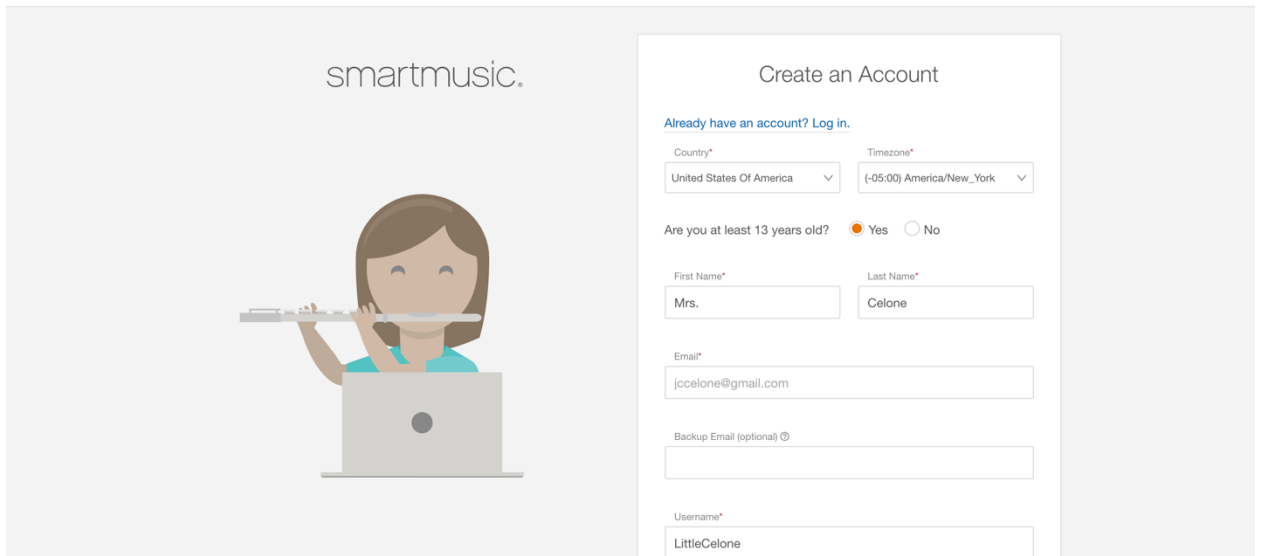

4. You will also need to enter an email address (this needs to be an address you actually have access to because they will send you a confirmation email to confirm your account)



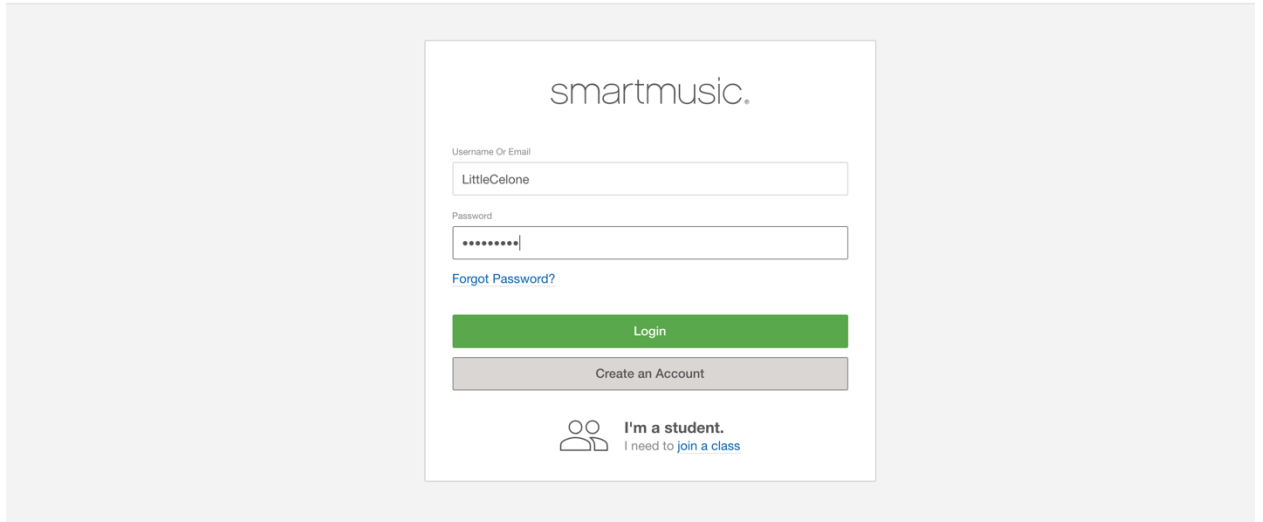
5. After confirming your account, you will be logged back in to set up your account. You will be asked to create a screen name, please use your first and last name or name and initial. You will also be asked to create a password, make it something easy for you to remember. They will want you to list your main instrument as well.



6. Once you do that, you can log in and access all the music!

To Login going forward!

1. On CHROME go to: home.smartmusic.com
2. Enter your screen name and password.



3. You will be taken to your home screen. Most of the content that you will want is on the right middle of the screen.
4. I would recommend starting with one of your books. Beginners, they have Essential Elements 2000, but they also have a number of other beginner books that would be fun to play out of! The nice thing about SmartMusic is that you don't actually have to own the book because they will show you the music on the screen. Check out Accent on Achievement Book 1, Band Expressions Book 1, Premier Performance Book 1 or Standard of Excellence Book 1. 7th and 8th graders they have the Habits book (your favorite!) But you may also want to check some of the "Book 2" versions of the beginner books mentioned above!
5. They also have all kinds of different pop/rock/movie theme songs! To find those, open the Band and Orchestra square on the right, then click the "Pop and Rock" filter on the left. You can find full band pieces or just solos with accompaniment.
6. You can RECORD and see where you are making mistakes! You can send them to me and let me give you feedback or just use it to self-evaluate!
